Summer Scholar Quick Facts

- \$3500 stipend award \$500 to go towards housing if you live on campus
- Full time commitment for 10 weeks of the summer
- You may not hold another summer job (paid or volunteer) or take summer courses without the written permission of the Undergraduate Research Program Director and your faculty mentor
- You are required to:
 - Register for UNIV 369 for both summer sessions
 - Attend the new scholar orientation meeting in April
 - Attend the Senior Thesis Symposium Saturday in May
 - Present at the Summer Celebratory Symposium in Aug.
 - Continue your research during the academic year for a total of 3 credits
- If you are a Science and Engineering Scholar you are also required to :
 - Attend the Summer Scholar Poster Session in April prior to the start of your summer scholarship
 - **Present** at the Summer Scholar Poster Session in the April **following** the summer of your scholarship
- If you are an **Arts, Humanities and Social Science** scholar you will be required to attend weekly meetings
- Notifications of awards will be made prior to the deadline for the Summer Fellowship program, so if you are not selected for Summer Scholars, you may still apply to the Summer Fellowship program.
